
Pop Stansell Park Flag Pole



Alex Thurin is a Life Scout with Boy Scout Troop 434 in Palm Harbor and one of his final requirements in earning the rank of Eagle Scout is to complete an Eagle Scout Service Project. His project is the Revitalization of the Entrance to Pop Stansell Park, which includes installing a new, fully functional flag pole. If enough funds are raised, the plan is to install a premium Eder manufactured, hurricane series, clear anodized, internal halyard, 40' pole, which Eder has agreed to supply at a big discount. The pole will have bollard (protective) posts surrounding it, along with lights to illuminate it throughout the night, acting as a guiding reference for boaters. There will also be a masonry base at the foundation of the pole with a plaque of dedication to Captain Dean Parks and to our servicemen and women.

Current Flagpole

The flagpole that currently occupies the entrance to Pop Stansell park was erected in 1986 by Pilot Club of Palm Harbor. Currently, it is not a functioning flagpole, is very weathered and needs to be replaced. The Original Plaque from the Pilot Club of Palm Harbor sits in ruin at the base of the current flag pole.

The pole will have bollard posts surrounding it, along with lights to illuminate it throughout the night, acting as a guiding reference for boaters. There will also be a masonry base at the foundation of the pole with a dedication plaque.
